# Our story began in 1919



**The Finnish Fair Corporation** was founded on 19 October 1919. The first fair was held at St. John's Church in Helsinki in 1920. The opening orchestra was led by Jean Sibelius. There were 120,000 visitors – more than Helsinki's population at that time.

The exhibition hall built at Mannerheimintie in 1935 was the largest exhibition facility in the Nordic countries. Nowadays, it is known as the Töölö Sports Hall, a paradise for football players and athletes.









The present-day Messukeskus was built in Pasila in 1975. Messukeskus was expanded over the years, and it was completely modernised in 2013.
